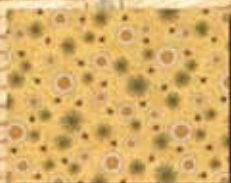

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Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

- Fabric A** - cut 2 - 9 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)
Fabric B - cut 2 - 9 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)
Fabric C - cut 1 - 9 1/2" square (center designs evenly)
 cut 4 - 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" sashing strips from smaller border stripes
Fabric E - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 3 1/2" squares (cornerstones)
BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half
Fabric F - cut 1 - 3 7/8" strip, subcut 8 - 3 7/8" squares to be paired with **Fabric H**
 cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 20 - 3 1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line on the backside of all squares
Fabric G - Border - cut 5 - 5" strips, subcut 2 - 5" x 39 1/2" (SIDES). Sew the remaining 3 strips together, end to end and subcut 2 - 5" x 48 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)
Fabric H - cut 1 - 3 7/8" strip, subcut 8 - 3 7/8" squares, to be paired with **F** squares.
 cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 3 1/2" squares
Fabric I - cut 2 - 9 1/2" strips, subcut 20 - 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" (sashing)
Fabric J - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 16 - 3 1/2" squares

2. Piecing Order:

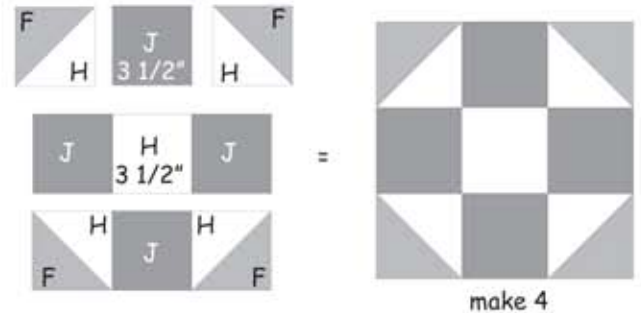
1. Make a total of five Snowball blocks: Place 3 1/2" (F) squares over each corner of A, B, and C - 9 1/2" squares, right sides together. Pay attention to the direction of the diagonal line according to the diagram. Stitch ON the drawn diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from seam and press outward.



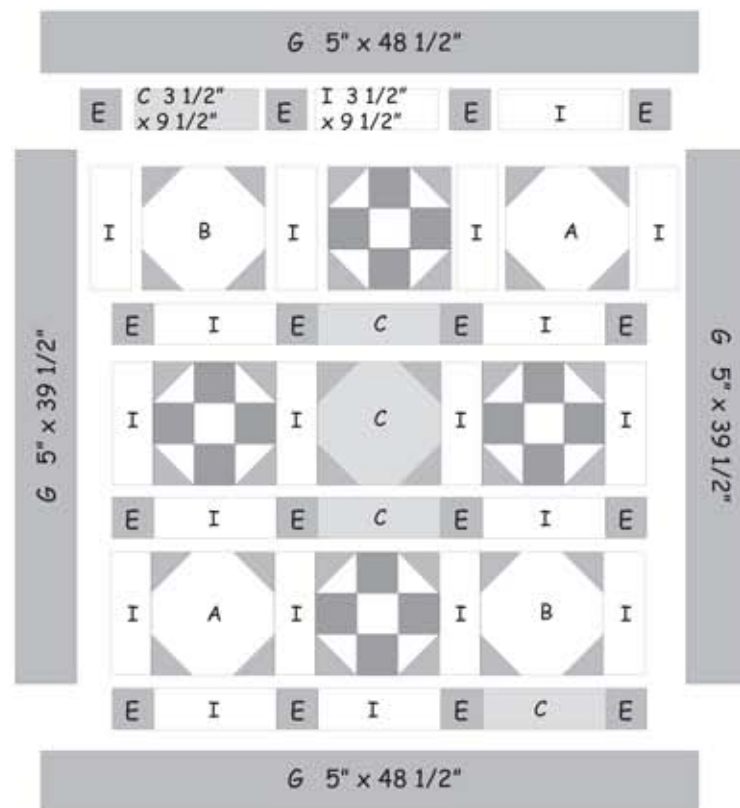
2. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of all H 3 7/8" squares. Pair one F and H square, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line and press toward F. Repeat for all 3 7/8" F and H squares and make 16 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.) half square triangle units.



3. Make 4 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unf.) Shoo-Fly Blocks by sewing units together by rows according to the diagram:



4. Sew block, sashing strips and cornerstones together by rows according to the diagram. Last, sew SIDE borders, then TOP and BOTTOM borders to the quilt.



5. Quilt measures approximately 48" x 48". Make backing (Fabric D) at least 6" larger than top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
